There really are alternatives to littering and dumping in our fragile Sonoran Desert! Here are a few places that take garbage and recycle items at nominal to no cost to you:

CR&R Environmental Services at 4081 N. Industrial Rd. off Highway 60, past Sunset Park. This business takes garbage for a mere \$10.00 for 400# or \$50 a ton. They don't take hazardous waste such as oil, car batteries, and tires cost \$11/tire. (928) 684-0303

Auto Zone, O'Reilly's and Napa Auto Parts all take car, motorcycle, and marine batteries and pay you for their return. They all take used automotive oil, free of water.

Family Recycling at 3600 Industrial Road takes lots of items for free like refrigerators, washers, cars (they will pick up), aluminum cans, plastic bottles, all types of metal, electric motors, and more. (928) 684-2421

Donation Centers: These non-profit businesses take furniture like chairs, couches, tables, and other household items that can be used by others:

Free Dump Days:

CR&R have free dump days in March. Watch for the dates in the Wickenburg Sun.

College Transfer Station has free dump days (they take tires!) March 18, 19, 20 and 25, 26, 27, 2021. Additionally, they take car tires off rims. for a mere \$0.50/tire and a bit more for larger tires.

Other smaller cities around Wickenburg have reduced fees for tires and free days.
